Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which you have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting. (Romans 16:17-18)

This seminar is a fair, comprehensive, biblical critique of the modern Word of Faith movement. Word-Faith theology (W-F) dominates Christian satellite and cable television and is making alarming inroads into more theologically conservative, evangelical churches. This seminar contains dozens of audio and video clips of various W-F preachers such as Benny Hinn, Kenneth and Gloria Copeland, Jesse Duplantis, Andrew Wommack, John Hagee, T.D. Jakes, Joyce Meyer, Joel Osteen, Rod Parsley, Creflo Dollar, Joseph Prince, Bill Johnson, etc. incorporated into a PowerPoint format. This format allows people to see and hear for themselves what these individuals are actually teaching. Everything then is, in turn, balanced with Scripture.

Sessions

The Duty of Discernment: *Sunday, May 20, 7:00 PM*

This session defines the W-F movement, defines discernment, gives the biblical precedent for it, and answers some of the common objections people will raise (e.g., "Judge not," "You shouldn't name names," and "Touch not My anointed," etc.) from Scripture.

Dangerous Doctrines: *Monday, May 21, 7:00 PM*

This is the first of the primary sessions; in it we will explore the metaphysical cultic origins of the movement as well as some of the standard doctrines which the Faith preachers teach that deviate from historical Christianity. We will look at the doctrines of positive confession, the little gods doctrine, softening of sin, spiritual death of Jesus (SDJ), and their errant Christology.

Mangled Manifestations: *Tuesday, May 22, 7:00 PM*

In this session, we will explore some of the more dramatic and spectacular aspects of the charismatic/W-F movement, such as the abuse of the gift of tongues, the practice of being slain in the Spirit, people who claim they have been to heaven (Jesse Duplantis, Don Piper, and Colton Burpo, etc.), false prophecies, and how God does and does not speak to us today.

The Hurt of Healing: *Wednesday, May 23, 7:00 PM*

In this final session, we'll examine the issue of physical healing. Is it always God's will for a believer to be healed? Is healing provided for in the atonement of Christ (per Isaiah 53:4-5)? If a person is not healed, is it because he does not have enough faith or has not "sown a seed to reap a harvest"? (No.) Does God still heal people today? (Yes, but only when it is His will.)
